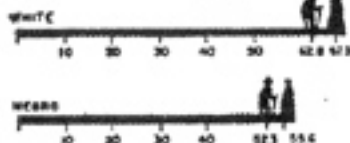

IS MORE THAN DOUBLE THAT OF WHITES

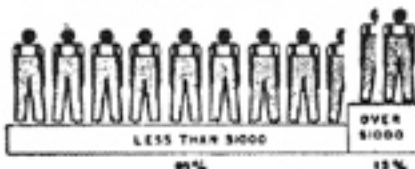

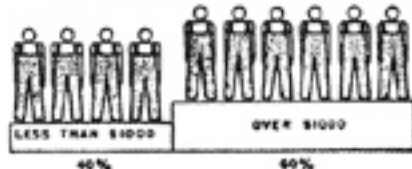
### SOME UNDERLYING CAUSES

#### 2 DISCRIMINATION IN MEDICAL FACILITIES...

IN 1946 ONLY 1% OF ALL HOSPITAL BEDS  
WERE AVAILABLE TO NEGROES (10% OF  
POPULATION)



...99% OF ALL HOSPITAL BEDS AVAILABLE TO OTHERS



APPROXIMATELY 1,490,000 BEDS

#### 3 SHORTAGE OF TRAINED NEGRO PERSONNEL...

(1942)



IN 1940 THERE WERE ONLY 7,192 TRAINED  
AND STUDENT NEGRO NURSES...



...AND ONLY 1,471 NEGRO DENTISTS
